It is almost a year since Kudos and the Community Theatre combined to form Kucom. This highly successful and vibrant new theatrical group has brought together the traditions and respectability of a 30 year contribution to theatre in Mackay and the enthusiasm and adventurous spirit of a group barely three years old. Immediately following this production, professional director Gilbert Spottiswood will arrive in Mackay to direct the classical Feydeau farce, "A Flea in Her Ear", for the group. This production promises to provide a fitting climax to a theatrically challenging and rewarding first year for Kucom as Gilbert Spottiswood comes to us with an established reputation as an excellent director of farce.
